A. The Spirit is given through faith (1-5, 14)

- 1. Galatians received Spirit through faith (1-5)
- 2. Spirit promised to all who have faith (v14)
- 3. Spirit is Christianity (Rom 8:9; Eph 1:13-14)
- 4. This comes from faith not works (2-5; Eph 1:13-14)
- B. Abrahamic blessings given through faith (6-9, 14)
 - 1. Abraham justified by faith (6)
 - 2. Children of Abraham by faith (7)
 - 3. God justifies Gentiles by faith (8)
 - 4. Abrahamic blessings given through faith (9)
- C. Redeemed from the curse of law by faith (10-13)
 - 1. Works of law bring curse not blessing (10-13)
 - a. Cursed for not doing everything in law (10; Dt 27:26)
 - b. The law does not justify faith does (11; Hab 2:4)
 - c. The law is the opposite of faith (12; Lev 18:5)
 - 2. Christ redeemed us from curse of law (13; Dt 21:23)
 - 3. Christ took the curse to give us the blessing! (13-14)

IV. The Path of Cursing, the Path of Blessing

A. Do you see there are two separate paths?

- 1. Works of law only lead to curse
- 2. Law is not based on faith opposite of faith
- 3. Law thunders against us shows no mercy
- B. The Good News: the blessings of faith!
 - 1. Christ has redeemed us from this path of cursing
 - 2. In him we receive righteousness
 - 3. In him we all spiritual blessings
 - 4. In Him we receive Spirit greatest gift of all!
 - 5. All this comes through faith in Christ not works
- C. Turn to Christ today and be blessed!

The Blessings of Faith

Galatians 3:1-14 February 20, 2005 ?????? Numbers 6 ¹ You foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? Before your very eyes Jesus Christ was clearly portrayed as crucified. ² I would like to learn just one thing from you: Did you receive the Spirit by observing the law, or by believing what you heard? ³ Are you so foolish? After beginning with the Spirit, are you now trying to attain your goal by human effort? ⁴ Have you suffered so much for nothing-- if it really was for nothing? Does God give you his Spirit and work miracles among you because you observe the law, or because you believe what you heard? 6 Consider Abraham: "He believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness." ⁷ Understand, then, that those who believe are children of Abraham. 8 The Scripture foresaw that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, and announced the gospel in advance to Abraham: "All nations will be blessed through you." 9 So those who have faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. 10 All who rely on observing the law are under a curse, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law." ¹¹ Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, "The righteous will live by faith." ¹² The law is not based on faith: on the contrary, "The man who does these things will live by them." ¹³ Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." ¹⁴ He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit. Galatians 3:1-14

⁹ You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ. Romans 8:9

¹³ And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, ¹⁴ who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession-- to the praise of his glory.
