Ruth 2:20 October 9, 2005 Communion Numbers 6 ??

- 6 "This is what the LORD says-- Israel's King and Redeemer, the LORD Almighty: I am the first and I am the last; apart from me there is no God. Isaiah 44:6
- 14 May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing in your sight, O LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer. Psalm 19:14
- 13 In your <u>unfailing love</u> you will lead the people you have <u>redeemed</u>. In your strength you will guide them to your holy dwelling. Exodus 15:13
- 20 "The LORD bless him!" Naomi said to her daughter-in-law. "He has not stopped showing his kindness to the living and the dead." She added, "That man is our close relative; he is one of our kinsman-redeemers." Ruth 2:20
- 6 "Therefore, say to the Israelites: 'I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians. I will free you from being slaves to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with mighty acts of judgment.'" Exodus 6:6

- 10 He saved them from the hand of the foe; from the hand of the enemy he redeemed them. Psalm 106:10
- 10 Do not move an ancient boundary stone or encroach on the fields of the fatherless, 11 for their Defender is strong; he will take up their case against you. Proverbs 23:10-11
- 19 The avenger of blood shall put the murderer to death; when he meets him, he shall put him to death. Numbers 35:19

- 11 Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family.
