- A. We live in a disposable culture
- B. Things of real value get restored not replaced
- C. God does not replace us He restores us

II. The Problem: Lost Fortunes

- A. The psalmist longs for salvation
 - 1. Salvation is deliverance from evil
 - 2. Salvation is restoration of the good
- B. The fortunes of people have been lost
 - 1. Restore fortunes must have been lost!
 - 2. The good (fortunes) has been taken away
- C. The people are in captivity
 - 1. "in the returning of the captives of his people"
 - 2. The people are held captive literally or spiritually

III. The Source of Problems: Satan, World, Sin

A. Satan longs to destroy and enslave

- 1. John 10:10; Rev 2:10; 12:9
- 2. Both physical and spiritual destruction & enslavement
- B. World opposes God and pulls us away from Him
 - 1. 1 John 2:15-17; James 4:4
 - 2. World stirs up longings that promise freedom but enslave
- C. Sin destroys and enslaves us
 - 1. Others sin 1 Cor 15:33; Romans 5:19
 - 2. Our sin John 8:34; Proverbs 5:22; Rom 6:23
 - 3. Like an infectious disease spreading death

IV. The Solution: The God of Restoration

- A. Salvation & restoration comes from the Lord!
 - 1. Salvation comes from Zion city of God
 - 2. Restoration comes from the Lord
- B. Jesus saves us from this slavery and death (Titus 3:3-7)
- C. Don Wheeler testimony

V. Conclusion & Summary

- A. Do you see that Satan, world and sin want to destroy you?
 - 1. They promise freedom but enslave no one sets out to be an addict!

- 2. They promise blessing but bring curse
- 3. They promise life but give death
- 4. Are we buying their lies?
- B. Do you see that God delights to restore?
 - 1. This is His very nature!
 - 2. He frees captives, blesses and gives life!
 - 3. Are we receiving His restoration?
- C. When He restores give Him thanks! (Ps 14:7)
