 - 1. Command v4; Gen 18:19; Dt 6:6-9; Ps 78:5-7
 - 2. Promises Gen 18:19; Dt 11:19-20
 - 3. No guarantee, but great reason for hope!

 - 2. Teaching and correction both necessary

 - 1. Unvarying exasperate (v4) if not!

 - 3. Regular Dt 6:6-9 home, away, see everywhere
