






## JESUS RULES EVERY SQUARE INCH!



















## WHEN WORK WAS WORSHIP

The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it.



## AFTER THE FALL TWO DISTINCT KINGDOMS

Redemptive Kingdom (Abraham)

After the fall, God instituted a distinction between the common kingdom, the realm of common grace ruled through general revelation, and the redemptive kingdom, the realm of saving grace ruled through special revelation.



- Remember that the church is not a citizen of two kingdoms - individual believers are
- Remember that our primary loyalty is now to the redemptive kingdom - our true home
- The common kingdom is not redemptive it is not the church, and does not do redemptive, church work
- When we do cultural work, we do it as sons of Adam
- Normally we base cultural work, arguments on general revelation (but we know truth from special revelation)
