- C. Today Paul warns us about being held captive
- D. But being held captive for nothing!

II. A Lurking Danger

- A. The command beware!
 - 1. NIV see to it idea is 'look out' 'beware'
 - 2. There are dangers all around them
 - 3. Being a Christian does not protect them
- B. The danger being taken captive
 - συλαγωγῶν only time in NT; first use ever
 - 2. 'To carry away as booty or spoil'
 - 3. Metaphor people taken captive after losing battle

III. The Means of Captivation

- A. The means hollow and deceptive philosophy
 - 1. Not an army the heart and mind!
 - 2. KJV philosophy and vain deceit 2 things
 - 3. NIV is correct one thing in view

- 4. It is an empty, deceitful philosophy
- B. The issue A philosophy that is empty & deceitful
 - 1. Issue is not philosophy but **this** philosophy
 - a. Philosophy in ancient world included wisdom, religion
 - b. Like our worldview today
 - 2. This philosophy is empty/hollow it can not deliver
 - a. The meaning of KJV vain not pride, but empty
 - b. This is why I titled this 'Captivated by **nothing**'
 - c. These ideas look grand but they are hollow
 - 3. This philosophy is deceptive it captivates
 - a. ἀπάτης deceit, especially involving pleasure
 - b. Gen 3:13 first use in LXX [2 Cor 11:3; 1 Tim 2:14]
 - c. Not just mental trick he enticed her to sin
 - d. Hearts & minds captivated then we are taken captive
 - e. This is why I titled this 'Captivated by nothing'
 - 4. Christians captivated by nothing without a fight!

IV. The Root Problem

- A. Philosophy built on a false foundation
 - 1. Human tradition & basic principles rather than Jesus
 - 2. This always leads to trouble unpack these ideas
- B. Human tradition rather than Jesus

- 1. Paul says this is just human ideas not God's
- 2. Contrast with 'receiving' Jesus in 2:6 (similar word)
- C. Basic principles of this world tough phrase
 - 1. A look at various translations of this phrase
 - 2. στοιχεῖα idea is building blocks of something else
 - a. Physical elements of universe
 - b. Rudimentary principles of religion, or world
 - c. Intermediary spirits who rule between humanity & gods
 - 3. I think it is a combination of these ideas especially b & c
 - a. Spirits Col 2:10, 15, 18
 - b. Rudimentary principles of world Col 2:20-21
 - 4. Spirits behind and ruling through this worlds principles
- D. The essential problem not based on Christ!!!

V. Our Modern Traditions, Spirits, & Principles

- A. Generation Me it's all about me
 - 1. This is the whole message of Joel Osteen
 - 2. Same temptation as in Genesis 3 it is about you!
 - 3. Rom 9:20-21 It's about God not us!
 - 4. Don't be deceived it is not about you!
- B. Money the desire for riches
 - 1. Seen in the popularity of the prosperity 'gospel'
 - 2. Matt. 13:22 deceitfulness (same word) of wealth

- 3. 1 Tim 6:5-10 desire for riches; plunge into ruin
- C. Relativism no universal truth, right wrong
 - 1. 68% of evangelical Gen-Y believe in universal right & wrong
 - 2. This means 1/3 do not!!!
 - 3. More and more think Jesus not the only way
 - 4. But Scripture is clear relativism is wrong
 - a. Isaiah 5:20 don't confuse good and evil!
 - b. John 14:6 Jesus is the ONLY WAY
- D. Unbridled pleasure especially sexual 'liberty' sin!
 - 1. Professing Christians proudly engage in sexual sin
 - 2. 'This is the way God made me'
 - 3. Eph. 4:22 put off old sinful self; deceitful desires
 - 4. Eph 5:5-6 don't be deceived; immorality judged
- E. An unbridled tongue
 - 1. Only getting worse with facebook, blogs, etc.
 - 2. People often show no restraint (or wisdom!)
 - 3. TV & radio shows, magazines just for gossip
 - 4. Matthew 12:36 words matter, and will be judged!
