- A. Theme: Jesus, the Lion, is King over all ruling everything for the glory of God and the good of God's people.

- E. Teaching keywords: Advent and Christmas, Jesus; Christology; kingdom of God; Lordship

III. Ox - The True Servant

- A. Theme: Jesus, the Ox, is the True servant of God, suffering and dying that we might have life.
- B. Text: Mark 10:45
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: Revelation 5:9-13 paraphrase
- E. Teaching keywords: Advent and Christmas, Jesus; Christology; salvation and deliverance
- F. Catechism Q22, 23

IV. Eagle - The True God

- A. Theme: Jesus, the Eagle, is the One True God, our Creator and Redeemer, Who became human for us and our salvation.
- B. Text: John 1:1-5, 14
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: 2 Peter 3:18
- E. Teaching keywords: Advent and Christmas, Jesus; Christology; Deity of Christ
- F. Catechism Q24
