I. The Lord of the Wedding Feast

- A. Theme: Jesus turned water into wine as a sign that He is the Lord of the New Covenant and its great wedding feast.
- B. Text: John 2:1-11
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: Genesis 27:28; Deuteronomy 33:15-16
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; God's glory; new covenant; eschatology

II. The Lord of the House

- A. Theme: Jesus cleansed the Temple as a sign that He is the Lord of God's House, and the True Temple of God.
- B. Text: John 2:13-25
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; God's glory; tabernacle and temple; faith; salvation and deliverance; worship

III. The Sovereign King

- A. Theme: Jesus is the Sovereign Lord over all Who calls us to embrace Him in humble faith for Who He is, not for what we want Him to do for us.
- B. Text: John 4:43-54
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: 1 Timothy 1:17
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; Sovereignty of God; Lordship; healing; faith; humility and pride

IV. The Lord of the Sabbath

- A. Theme: Jesus healed the lame man with His powerful word on the Sabbath to show that He is Lord of the Sabbath because He is One with God the Father and does the works of the Father.
- B. Text: John 5:1-18
- C. Response: Prayer
- D. Benediction: 2 John 1:3
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; Sabbath and rest

V. The Lord Who Feeds His People

- A. Theme: Jesus fed the multitude as a sign that He is the True Bread of Life, Who came down from heaven so that whoever feeds upon Him through believing in Him would have eternal life.
- B. Text: John 6:1-15
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: Philippians 4:19
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; faith

VI. The Lord of Light

- A. Theme: Jesus healed the man who was blind from birth to show that He is the Messiah, the Light of the world, Who came to call sinful humans out of the darkness into His glorious light.
- B. Text: John 9:1-7
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: Psalm 27:1-4 paraphrase
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; salvation and deliverance; faith

VII. The Lord of Life

- A. Theme: Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead to show that He is the Lord of Life, and that everyone who believes in Him has eternal life.
- B. Text: John 11
- C. Response: Prayer
- D. Benediction: Revelation 1:4-5
- E. Teaching keywords: Christology; Deity of Christ; Lent; miraculous gifts and signs; death; resurrection; faith; Easter
