VII. Yahweh Rohi - The Lord My Shepherd

A. Theme: Do I know the Lord as my Shepherd well enough to place my complete trust in him for my life?

VIII. Yahweh Raphe - The Lord the Healer

X. Yahweh Shalom - The Lord is Peace

A. Theme: God's Name Yahweh Shalom - The Lord is Peace - speaks of God's desire and ability to restore everything to its proper purpose so that I can be related properly to God, myself, and others.

B. Text: Judges 6:22-24

C. Reading: Ephesians 2:11-18

D. Response: Prayer

E. Benediction: 2 Thessalonians 3:16
