 - 2. Anointed with oil, representing Spirit (Is 61:1)
 - 3. Prophets, priests, and kings in Old Testament
 - 4. Kings especially Davidic Ps 89:20; 18:50
- B. King David and his descendants
 - 1. Israel's kings ruled for God
 - 2. Whose throne? 1 Kings 2:12; 1 Chron 29:23
- C. Son David and his descendants

- 1. This person is God's son
- 2. David & seed Ps 89:20, 26-29; 2 Sam 7:12-16
- D. Messiah/King/Son originally refers to Davidic King
 - 1. He was anointed king and son
 - 2. Psalm 2 probably used to set him in
 - 3. But is there a more fundamental meaning?
 - 4. Do Davidic kings really fulfill this Psalm?
