    - b. Then avoid (v10; Rom 16:17)
    - c. Issue divisive & self-condemned (v10-11; 2 Ti 2:23)

  - 1. Foolish, controversial, argumentative (v9; 2 Ti 2:23)
  - 2. Unprofitable and useless (v9)
  - 3. Speculate; never truth or change (2 Ti 3:6-7)

  - 1. v14 literally 'unfruitful'
  - 2. Contrasting fruitful vs. useless
- B. Fruitful in good works
  - 1. Produce good works (v8, 14)
  - 2. Key theme in letter (2:7, 14; 3:1)
  - 3. False teachers no good works (3:9; 1:16)
- C. What are the good works? (v14)
  - 1. Provide for own needs (NIV; 2 Th 3:6-8, 9-10)
  - 2. Give help to others (ESV; Eph 4:28; v13-14)

### A Fruitful Life Devoted to Good Works

Titus 3:8-15 July 16, 2006 ????

Psalm 1:2-3 paraphrase (fruitful)

- 23 Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels... 25 Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, 26 and that they will come to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his will. 2 Timothy 2:23-26
- 17 I urge you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them. Romans 16:17
- 23 Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. 2 Timothy 2:23
- ... who are loaded down with sins and are swayed by all kinds of evil desires, 7 always learning but never able to acknowledge the truth. 2 Timothy 3:6-7

We were not idle when we were with you, 8 nor did we eat anyone's food without paying for it.
