Disciples and Grace 2 Timothy 2:1-7 September 10. 2006 Amazing Grace 2 Corinthians 13:14 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus. Romans 3:23-24
