## II. Crowning Act of Creation – Mankind

- A. Mankind is the crowning act of creation
  - 1. Mankind is the final thing God creates
  - 2. Declaration of God's plan only here (v26)
  - 3. "Let us" in place of "let there be" personal (v26)
  - 4. God breathes into man directly (2:7)
  - 5. Shift to poetry (vs 27)
  - 6. Man rules the rest of creation (1:26, 28)
  - 7. Man alone is the image of God (1:26, 27)
- B. Mankind has a special place in creation
  - 1. We are still but a creature but important
  - 2. Others excel us in many ways but we are image

## III. What Is Man?

- A. Man is uniquely spirit-flesh being
  - 1. Man formed of dust and spirit (2:7)
  - 2. Animals dirt (1:24); angels spirit (Heb 2:14)
  - 3. Man is necessarily dirt-spirit BOTH
    - a. Dirt Adam/Adamah; Gen 3:19; Ps 103:14
    - b. Spirit Job 33:4 (same word); Zech 12:1
    - c. Gen 2:7; Job 34:14-15; Mat 10:28
- B. Man is (not possesses) the image of God
  - 1. Genesis 1:26-27; 5:1
  - 2. Male and female Gen 1:27; Gen 5:1-2
  - 3. All humans not just kings (Gen 1:27)
  - 4. The image is MAN body-spirit not part
    - a. Many say some quality it is MAN himself
    - b. We have qualities in different degrees but not image
    - c. Includes physical (5:1-3; 9:6; idols/tumors; see, hear)
    - d. Image inexact knowledge; male/female; rule; physical

## IV. Applying the Word

- A. Do we see the importance of mankind?
  - 1. Not just more highly evolved image of God
  - 2. We are not just part of creation we rule it
  - 3. Do we treat all others as the image of God?
- B. Do we see that we are flesh-spirit beings?
  - 1. Creation, fall, redemption all are flesh-spirit
  - 2. Many want to divide them denigrate one
  - 3. Example 1 Corinthians 6:15-20
  - 4. Impacts all of life worship, diet, relationships
- C. Christ the True Image restores it in us!
  - 1. 2 Cor 4:4 Christ the Image of God (Col 1:15)
  - 2. Image restored in us Col 3:9-11; Rom 8:29
