- E. How do citizens of heaven live together?

# II. Basis of Appeal – Our Riches in Christ

- A. Paul lists 4 realities in Christ (v1)
  - 1. If but assumes they are true
  - 2. Encouragement from Christ even in suffering
  - 3. Comfort from love (of God the Father)
  - 4. Fellowship/participation with the Spirit
  - 5. 2 Corinthians 13:14//Phi 2:1
  - 6. Tenderness & compassion/mercy (from God)
- B. Strong basis for appeal
  - 1. All Christians have experienced these things

2. These blessings motivate us to obey

## III. The Appeal: Unity

- A. An introductory basis for appeal (again!)
  - 1. Then make my joy complete (v2)
  - 2. Looks like appeal, but really another basis
- B. The appeal stated 4 ways! (ESV)
  - 1. Being like-minded of the same mind
  - 2. Having the same love
  - 3. In full accord of one soul
  - 4. One in purpose lit. of one mind
  - 5. φρονεω 10 of 23 in Paul; 2:5; 4:2; 4:10
  - 6. Mind in Christ; towards Paul; each other!!!
- C. Four statements one reality Unity!
  - 1. All four things speak of unity
  - 2. Does not mean agree on everything
  - 3. Does speak of an attitude with each other

### IV. Barriers to Unity – And the Way Forward

A. Barriers in attitude – destroy unity

- 1. Selfish ambition rivalry also in 1:17
- 2. Vain conceit proud but empty!
- B. The right attitude humility
  - 1. This is the opposite of the other 2 attitudes
  - 2. Humility begins before God (1 Pet 5:5-6)
  - 3. Others as better = surpassing/more important
- C. Humility in action (v4)
  - 1. Look to others needs as well as my own
  - 2. 2<sup>nd</sup> great commandment, golden rule in action
  - 3. Done by "each of you" all must do this!

#### V. **Applying the Word**

- A. Do we see the great riches we have in Christ?
  - 1. Encouragement, love, participation, mercy
  - 2. Forgiven, adopted, blessed no matter what!
- B. Do these blessings produce humility before God & others?
  - 1. Humility not a virtue in Western Civ. weakness
  - 2. Not even listed in the book of virtues!
  - 3. Are we humble before God?

- 4. Has this changed our attitude before others?
- 5. Do I put others before myself? I AM THIRD
- C. Do we walk in unity with others?
  - 1. Do I see the indispensable nature of local church?
  - 2. Do I walk in humble unity or proud disunity?
  - 3. Stand for truth humbly!!
- D. Communion with Christ and the church
