James 1:26-27 March 9, 2008 Testimony by Strub's - Anna's dedication 2 Corinthians 13:14

- 5 A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling. Psalm 68:5
- 22 Do not take advantage of a widow or an orphan. 23 If you do and they cry out to me, I will certainly hear their cry. 24 My anger will be aroused, and I will kill you with the sword; your wives will become widows and your children fatherless. Exodus 22:22-24

Every 15 seconds another child becomes an AIDS orphan in Africa

In Ukraine and Russia:

10-15% of unadopted orphans commit suicide before 18

A massive number of children sold as sex slaves
