II. The Spirit – Sent By Jesus

- A. The Counselor the Holy Spirit
 - 1. Used 5 times all by John
 - a. John 15:26; 14:16-17; 14:26; 16:7
 - b. Jesus is 1st 1Jn 2:1 ESV
 - 2. The Spirit is now doing what Christ did
- B. The Spirit is sent by Jesus (Jn 15:26)
 - 1. Jesus sends Counselor Jn 15:26; Jn 16:7
 - 2. Spirit Baptism Mt 3:11; Lk 24:49; Acts 2:33
- C. The Holy Spirit The Spirit of Christ

III. The Spirit - Sent To Testify About Jesus

- A. The Spirit testifies about Jesus
 - 1. Jn 15:26; 16:8-11; 16:13-15; 1 Jo 5:6-9
 - 2. The Spirit always points to Christ!

- B. The necessity of the Spirit's testimony
 - 1. Jesus no longer here in person
 - 2. The Spirit does His work and points to Him
 - 3. Only the Spirit can do this

IV. The Spirit – Empowering Us To Testify

- A. We also must testify about Jesus
 - 1. Jn 15:26 apostles (and secondarily us)
 - 2. Lk 24:46-48 preach to all; witnesses (noun form)
 - 3. Acts 5:30-32 we and Spirit testify of Gospel
- B. Spirit empowers us to testify
 - 1. Lk 24:48-49 testify, but empowered by Spirit
 - 2. Acts 1:8 power to be witnesses
 - 3. Acts 4:31 filled with Spirit; spoke word boldly

V. Applying the Word

- A. Do we see that the Spirit points to Christ not Himself?
 - 1. He was sent by Christ for this express purpose
 - 2. This is always His work point to Christ
 - 3. Todd B. don't talk about Christ deceived
- B. Do we see that being Spirit filled = passionate about Jesus?
 - 1. He is the Spirit of Christ (Rom 8:9)

- 2. He reveals Christ and His glory to us
- 3. Spirit filled Not about 'time travel in Spirit'
- C. Do we see Spirit empowers us to testify about Jesus?
 - 1. Our passion is about Him not even other issues
 - 2. Empowers us to testify by life and words
 - 3. Must be done in power of Spirit not programs, gimmicks
 - 4. Only Spirit can change the heart
 - 5. Cry out for Him to work through us
- D. Communion Spirit links us to Christ & His work

The Spirit and Jesus

John 15:26-27 September 21, 2008 Communion 2 Corinthians 13:14

- ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Counselor to be with you forever-- ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. John 14:16-17
- ²⁶ But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you. John 14:26
- ⁷ But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. John 16:7
- ¹ My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 1 John 2:1 ESV
- ⁷ But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. John 16:7
- ¹¹ I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire. Matthew 3:11
- ⁴⁹ I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high. Luke 24:49
- ³³ Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear. Acts 2:33
- ⁹ You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ. Romans 8:9
- ⁸ When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment: ⁹ in regard to sin, because men do not believe in me; ¹⁰ in regard to righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; ¹¹ and in regard to judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned. John 16:8-11

- ¹³ But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. ¹⁴ He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. ¹⁵ All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you. John 16:13-15
- ⁶ This is the one who came by water and blood-- Jesus Christ. He did not come by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit who testifies, because the Spirit is the truth. ⁷ For there are three that testify: ⁸ the Spirit, the water and the blood; and the three are in agreement. ⁹ We accept man's testimony, but God's testimony is greater because it is the testimony of God, which he has given about his Son. 1 John 5:6-9
- ⁴⁶He told them, "This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷ and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. ⁴⁸You are witnesses of these things. Luke 24:46-48
- ³⁰ The God of our fathers raised Jesus from the dead-- whom you had killed by hanging him on a tree. ³¹ God exalted him to his own right hand as Prince and Savior that he might give repentance and forgiveness of sins to Israel. ³² We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him." Acts 5:30-32
- ⁴⁸ You are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹ I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high. Luke 24:48-49
- ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8
