- C. No 3rd aspect God's unrevealed individual will
 - 1. Eph 5:17 This is God's revealed moral will
 - 2. God's will for me: sanctification (1Th 4:3 ESV)
 - 3. All normally used are secret or revealed moral will
- D. What about things not in Bible how decide?

III. Biblical Decision Making - The Way of Wisdom

A. God's will is that we walk in wisdom

- 1. Eph 5:15-18 wisdom, will, Spirit filled same
- 2. Col 1:9 knowledge of will through wisdom
- B. Wisdom is closely related to holiness
 - 1. Eph 5:15-18 wisdom, filled with Spirit same
 - 2. James 3:13, 17 wisdom of a good life; character
 - 3. Job 28:28 fear of Lord, shun evil wisdom
 - 4. Pro 2:9-11 right, just, fair, synonyms
- C. Principles of wise decision making
 - 1. Where Scripture speaks it must be obeyed
 - 2. Scripture govern goals, attitudes, actions
 - 3. Makes the most of every opportunity (Eph 5:15-16)
 - 4. Seeks counselors (Pro 15:22)
 - 5. Considers circumstances open/closed doors at this time
 - 6. If goals, attitudes correct, choose as please
 - 7. Wisdom is a path we grow over time
 - 8. Wisdom trusts God to work all for our good

IV. Applying the Word

- A. Do we see God's will is wisdom not "finding perfect will"?
 - 1. This is the clear call of Scripture
 - 2. The "perfect will" does not exist, can't be found
 - 3. Wisdom does exist, and God promises it

- B. Are we growing in wisdom?
 - 1. Am I walking with Christ, the Wisdom of God?
 - 2. Am I soaking in Scripture?
 - 3. Am I spending time with the wise? (Pro 13:20)
- C. Are we growing in holiness becoming like Christ?
 - 1. This is the heart of God's will
 - 2. This is the heart of wisdom
 - 3. A lack here will lead to terrible decisions
 - 4. We need to be transformed
 - 5. Includes thought, attitude, action
- D. Communion
