- A. The biblical usage only 4 times!
 - 1. Gospels Mt 4:1; Luk 4:1 unique
 - 2. Rom 8:14; Gal 5:17 same point
- B. Led by the Spirit to obey revealed will (Scripture)
 - 1. Rom 8:12-14 sinful nature vs Spirit
 - a. Rom 8:4 fulfill law; Spirit vs sinful nature
 - b. Rom 8:5 Spirit vs sinful nature
 - c. Rom 8:9 Spirit vs sinful nature control
 - 2. Gal 5:16-18 sinful nature vs. Spirit
 - a. Followed by acts of sinful nature, fruit of Spirit
 - b. Whole context is holy living to fulfill law
 - 3. Psalm 143:2, 10 Spirit lead, level ground

C. Spirit led = obedient to God's revealed will in Scripture

III. The Spirit's Role in Our Sanctification

- A. Spirit revealed God's will in Scripture
 - 1. Spirit inspired 2 Pet 1:21
 - 2. Guide into truth apostles John 16:13
- B. Spirit lets us understand Scripture 1Co 2:14
- C. Spirit gives desire to follow Rom 8:14-16
- D. Spirit enables us to obey God Rom 8:3-4; Gal 5:17-18
- E. Spirit is central in knowing and doing God's will

IV. Applying the Word

- A. Do we have a biblical understanding of 'led by Spirit'?
 - 1. It is about knowing and doing revealed will
 - 2. Not about following subjective promptings
 - 3. Not an excuse for bad decisions or bizarre behavior
- B. Are we Spirit led people?
 - 1. Idea of 'spiritual' in cultural is actually demonic
 - 2. Have you turned to Christ in faith only way!
 - 3. Believers Spirit leading in greater obedience?
 - 4. Must continue to cry out for Him to fill, lead, empower
- C. Are we grateful for Spirit's role in all of this?
