- C. Plan Joshua fights; Moses on hill (v9)
- D. Progress Moses' hands determine (v11)
- E. Problem & solution tired; helpers (v12)
- F. Outcome Israel's victory (v13)
- G. The Name and continued strife (v15-16)

III. The Meaning of Yahweh Nissi

- A. Banner its basic meaning
 - 1. Banner pole (Num 21:8-9); sign (Num 26:10)
 - 2. Banner seen/observed

- 3. Came to be rallying point like our flag (Is 5:26)
- B. Central idea reminder that God is our deliverer
 - 1. Special banner Moses' part in battle
 - a. Takes staff of God plagues; Red Sea (v9)
 - b. Moses' actions determine battle (v11)
 - c. Picture of prayer [Psa 141:2; 1 Tim 2:8]
 - d. Battle is essentially spiritual even then
 - 2. Special enemy Amalekites
 - a. Perpetual warfare (v16)
 - b. Warfare during Saul's reign [1 Sam 15:1-3]
 - c. Esther still trying to destroy Israel
 - 1. Haman the Agagite (Esth 3:1)
 - 2. Mordecai from Kish (2:5) 1Sam!!!
 - 3. Only delivered as Esther pleads before throne!
- C. Yahweh Nissi Banner of deliverance from age to age!

IV. Yahweh Nissi in New Covenant

- A. Jesus is Yahweh Nissi
 - 1. Root of Jesse; banner; peoples (Is 11:10-12)
 - 2. Jesus lifted up on banner like serpent (Jn 3:14-15)
- B. The age of physical holy war is over
 - 1. Israel was theocratic nation govt, army

- 2. This is no longer true no Christian nation
- 3. Our warfare is spiritual (Eph 6:11-12; armor)
- 4. We do not fight as world (2 Cor 10:3-5)
- 5. Our enemies are spiritual not physical
- 6. Our weapons spiritual not physical
- 7. The battle is spiritual not physical

V. Applying the Word

 - 1. There has been cosmic war since Satan rebelled
 - 2. We can be lulled to sleep and forget it's wartime!
 - 3. Yahweh-Nissi reminds us of the war

 - 2. Our enemy is NOT people pastors conversation
 - 3. Christian's have failed at this throughout history
 - 4. Crusades wrong age of redemptive history!
 - 5. Politics, culture war is NOT spiritual warfare

 - 1. Our warfare done by prayer, service, Word, love

- 2. Spiritual warfare is corporate (Eph 6 plural; Aaron, Hur)
- 3. Jesus is our Banner!!!
- 4. He determines goals, guides, delivers, conquers
- D. Communion the Lord Our Banner
 - 1. Jesus has delivered us from our enemies
 - 2. Jesus has provided all we need
 - 3. Jesus leads us on in triumph!
