#### The Joy of Corporate Worship Psalm 122:1 Psalm 133 February 21, 2010

Communion Numbers 6:24-26 Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you? 1 Corinthians 3:16

In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. 22 And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit. Ephesians 2:21-22

But you have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousand++s upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly, 23 to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven.
