Theme: As God's exile, sojourning people, Christians are called to resist sin and live lives devoted to good works, hoping that God will use these to draw unbelievers to the Gospel.

II. Exiles - Our Status As God's People

- A. God's sojourning people (v11)
 - 1. Strangers and aliens (v11)
 - 2. πάροικος aliens Gen 15:13; Acts 7:29
 - 3. παρεπίδημος strangers 1 Pet 1:1; Heb 11:13
 - 4. Someone not at home; vulnerable outsider
 - 5. Genesis 23:4 like Abraham chosen, exile
- B. Our status as God's people
 - 1. Not asking to be this we already are

- 2. Called by God aliens and strangers (vv9-11)
- 3. All commands on how to live based on this
- 4. Response of culture to us based on this

III. Living As Exiles - Abstain From Sin (Negative)

- A. As exiles abstain from sinful desires
 - 1. Literally 'desires of the flesh'
 - 2. 'Desires of men' 1 Pet 4:2
 - 3. Desires against will of God, righteousness
 - 4. Can be sexual, drunk, etc 1 Pe 4:2-3
 - 5. Can be rebellion, etc 2 Pet 2:10; 1 Pe 2:13ff
 - 6. ANYTHING that goes against God's Word
- B. Why we must abstain from sinful desires
 - 1. Our status as aliens & strangers demands it
 - 2. They war against our soul/life
 - 3. They promise freedom give slavery
 - 4. They promise joy but bring pain
- C. But note this will bring conflict with culture!!! (v12)

IV. Living As Exiles - Doing Good Works (Positive)

- A. Good conduct and good works (v12)
 - 1. Good conduct win approval of Gentiles

- 2. Four of six in 1 Peter effect on outsiders (3:1-2; 3:16)
- 3. Good works effect on Gentiles (v12; Mt 5:16)
- 4. May speak evil but good works may win over (v12)
- B. Positive effect of good works
 - 1. Resisting sin will produce conflict
 - 2. But we must be known for good conduct & works
 - 3. This has powerful effect on unbelievers

V. Applying the Word

- A. Do we see we are aliens and strangers?
 - 1. Do we see this is part of our conversion?
 - 2. To be God's people is to be an alien here
 - 3. Where is my prime allegiance?
 - 4. Rich Mullins Land of My Sojourn (Paradox!)
- B. Do we abstain from sinful desires?
 - 1. Do we see as aliens we will always be at war?
 - 2. We simply must abstain from many parts of culture
 - 3. What molds me spirit of age or Christ?
 - 4. Jesus Through the Centuries do I do this?
- C. Do we live lives of good works?
 - 1. Am I more known for what I am against, or what I do?
 - 2. Do people think of us a servants or warriors?

D. Lets be known for the Gospel!!

- 1. We are saved by God's mercy not our righteousness
- 2. We preach God's mercy not our righteousness
- 3. We display God's mercy not our judgmental attitudes

Living As God's Exile People

Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, To God's elect, strangers in the world, scattered 1 Peter 1:1

All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance. And they admitted that they were aliens and strangers on earth. Hebrews 11:13
