<p>Jonah 2:2</p> <p>“I called out to the LORD, out of my distress, and he answered me”</p>	<p>Psalm 120:1</p> <p>In my distress I called to the LORD, and he answered me.</p> <p>Psalm 18:6</p> <p>In my distress I called upon the LORD; to my God I cried for help.</p>
<p>Jonah 2:3</p> <p>all your waves and your billows passed over me.</p>	<p>Psalm 42:7</p> <p>all your breakers and your waves have gone over me. (The Hebrew phrase is identical to Jonah's prayer)</p>
<p>Jonah 2:4</p> <p>Then I said, ‘I am driven away from your sight’</p>	<p>Psalms 31:22</p> <p>I had said in my alarm, “I am cut off from your sight.”</p>
<p>Jonah 2:4</p> <p>yet I shall again look upon your holy temple.</p>	<p>Psalms 5:7</p> <p>I will bow down toward your holy temple</p>
<p>Jonah 2:5</p> <p>The waters closed in over me to take my life; the deep surrounded me; weeds were wrapped about my head</p>	<p>Psalms 69:1</p> <p>Save me, O God! For the waters have come up to my neck.</p> <p>Psalms 18:4–5</p> <p>⁴ The cords of death encompassed me; the torrents of destruction assailed me; ⁵ the cords of Sheol entangled me; the snares of death confronted me.</p>
<p>Jonah 2:7</p> <p>When my life (or soul) was fainting away,</p>	<p>Psalms 142:3</p> <p>When my spirit faints within me,</p>

<p>Jonah 2:7</p> <p>and my prayer came to you, into your holy temple.</p>	<p>Psalms 18:6</p> <p>From his temple he heard my voice, and my cry to him reached his ears.</p>
<p>Jonah 2:8</p> <p>Those who pay regard to vain idols</p>	<p>Psalms 31:6</p> <p>I hate those who pay regard to worthless idols</p>
<p>Jonah 2:9</p> <p>But I with the voice of thanksgiving will sacrifice to you; what I have vowed I will pay.</p>	<p>Psalms 50:14</p> <p>Offer to God a sacrifice of thanksgiving, and perform your vows to the Most High</p>
