Introduction

Theme of the 1 Peter- Holiness through Suffering

1Pet. 2:9 But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. **10** Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. (Slide)

Chosen Race

- 1. Chosen Race- When God choses his choice is final and absolute
 - 1. Royal- God chose David to be king
 - 2. Priesthood- God chose Aaron to be priest
 - 3. Holy- God chose the temple to be holy
 - 4. Nation God chose Israel to be his treasured possession
- 2. Fulfilled in the New Testament Church God choosing in the OT finds fulfillment in the NT
- 3. Suffering- Believers are strengthened in suffering when they understand God chose them

Royal Priesthood, Holy Nation, Treasured Possession

- 1. Exodus 19- Peter's description of believer is found in Exodus 19
 - 1. Consecrated (Ex. 19:10)- To Enter the Presence of God We Must be Pure
 - 2. The People and the Priest Fail the Test Israel's failure to be pure kept them from God's presence
 - 3. Moses and Aaron as Holy and Priest Moses and Aaron entered the presence of God because of their purity
- 2. Christ the True Holy and Royal Priest

Key Observations (slide)

- Entering the presence of God brings the believer pleasure (Psa. 16:11)
- Purity is only done through suffering (1 Pet. 1:7-9)
