ROMANS 10:6-10

But the righteousness based on faith says, “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’” (that is, to bring Christ down) **7** “or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’” (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). **8** But what does it say? “**The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart**” (that is, the word that we proclaim); **9**

because, if you **confess with your mouth** that Jesus is Lord and **believe in your heart** that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.

JOHN 14:15-24

21 Whoever has my commandments and **keeps them, he it is who loves me**. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.” **22** Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, “Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself to us, and not the world?” **23** Jesus answered him, “**If anyone**

loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and **make our home with him**. **24** Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not mine but the Father’s who sent me.
