

## **Purity in an Impure Age**

## Key idea:

The world is constantly working to press us into its mold. Jesus promises the blessing of seeing God if, in humility, we allow Him to purify our hearts through single-mindedly focusing on Him.

Matthew 5:8 (ESV)

Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

## **Key points:**

- 1. The heart of human beings is the seat of our spirituality. It is the place where we are either in tune with the world or with God.
- 2. Double-mindedness is impurity mixed with purity. And that mixture is, by definition, impurity.
- 3. Purity of heart is a single focus on God and His Word.
- 4. Jesus promises that we will have the blessing of having the clarity seeing God if we allow Him to purify our hearts.
- 5. Drawing near to God in humility is the avenue to a pure heart.

## Questions for discussion/application:

- 1. What part of Sunday's teaching stood out most to me? Why?
- 2. How does double-mindedness keep us from seeing God?
- 3. In what practical ways can I combat impurity and cultivate purity of heart in my life?
- 4. How is "seeing God" related to love?
- 5. How does waging spiritual warfare affect our purity of heart?
- 6. Why is this blessing for Christians only?

7. Are there other believers with whom I can share what I have learned this week? Pray for them and ask God to open a door for you to share His Word.
