

Stillness

Key idea:

Christians are called to trust that God is our defender and deliverer so that we might delight in our God.

Key text:

Psalm 46 (ESV)

Psa. 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

- Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea,
- though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. Selah
- Psa. 46:4 There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God, the holy habitation of the Most High.
- God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved; God will help her when morning dawns.
- The nations rage, the kingdoms totter; he utters his voice, the earth melts.
- 7 The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah
- Psa. 46:8 Come, behold the works of the LORD, how he has brought desolations on the earth.
- He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; he breaks the bow and shatters the spear; he burns the chariots with fire.
- "Be still, and know that I am God.

 I will be exalted among the nations,
 I will be exalted in the earth!"
- The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. Selah

Key points:

Questions for discussion/application:

- 5. Read Ezekiel 47:1-9. What is the significance of the river flowing from the temple?
- 6. What is the benefit of stillness or the practice of solitude?
- 7. What does a place of solitude look like to you? What will you do when you practice solitude?
- 8. How can you practice solitude in community with other believers (If you have a family, how can you practice solitude as a family?)?
- 9. Who will I call or see to encourage this week? Who can I encourage to worship this King this coming Sunday?
