

The Blessed Community of Prayer

Key idea:

God commands a blessing upon His people who live in unity through gathered worship and shared lives.

Key text:

Psalm 133

- ¹ How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity!
- ² It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron's beard, down upon the collar of his robes.
- ³ It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion. For there the Lord bestows his blessing, even life forevermore.

Key points:

- 1. It is good and pleasant for Christian brothers and sisters to live in unity with one another.
- 2. When Christians live in unity it is like an abundance of precious anointing oil and an outpouring of dew in a dry land.
- 3. God commands a blessing on His people who live in unity with one another through gathered worship and shared lives.
- 4. The blessing described in Psalm 133 has three characteristics:
 - It comes down from God to His people
 - It is abundant and overflowing
 - It is eternal
- 5. If I desire the blessing of God, I must be where He commands blessing in Jesus Christ and His people as they gather for worship and share life in unity with one another.

Questions for discussion/application:

1. What part of Sunday's teaching stood out most to you? Why?

- 2. What would it have been like to take a pilgrimage to Jerusalem and finally see it and the Temple for the first time? How would I react to reciting this Psalm at that moment?
- 3. Have I experienced true community that is "good and pleasant"? What made that experience so good and pleasant?
- 4. Have I experienced relationships that were not "good and pleasant"? What made them hurtful or unpleasant?
- 5. When I think of being blessed, what comes to my mind? Is it primarily eternal life as in Psalm 133? If not, what is it?
- 6. How does Psalm 133 point to Jesus Christ? How is He a fulfillment of this Psalm? (See After Hours for a discussion of this idea).
- 7. How is Acts 2:42-47 a fulfillment of Psalm 133? What does it teach me about what life in the people of God should look like today?
- 8. What actions can I take in the next two weeks to grow in community with at least one other believer in BRCC?
- 9. Who will I call or see to encourage this week? How will I work to share life with them this week?
