A List of Biblical Blessings To Pray Over Others.

On December 31, 2023 I taught on 'The Blessing of God' from Number 6:24-26. It is probably the most famous biblical blessing. But there are many others in the Scripture. We periodically use each of these different blessings as the benediction/blessing at the end of our meeting. I am giving them here as a guide you can print as your pray or speak these over others. You can also use them as a guide in praying for your own needs before the Lord.

Genesis 12:2-3

I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. ³ I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you.

Genesis 27:28

May God give you of heaven's dew and of earth's richness — an abundance of grain and new wine.

(From Genesis 27:28; Deuteronomy 33:15-16)
