II. Called To Be God's Instruments In the World

A. Theme: God has called us to be His instruments in this fallen world, allowing Him to work through us to bring blessing in every realm of life and every corner of creation.

D. Benediction: Genesis 12:2-3

III. Understanding Our Calling

VI. Called To Work (Part 2)

A. Theme: God's favor on our work does not come from doing a specific type of job, but from working with all our heart in the job to which God calls us, doing our best to please God and serve others through our labors.

VII. Called To the Church

A. Theme: When Christ calls us through the Gospel, He calls us into local churches where we can be protected, strengthened and equipped by those whom Christ has saved and called to be leaders in the church.

D. Benediction: Hebrews 13:20-21

VIII. Called To Family

A. Theme: Christians are called to serve God in their families by loving and respecting their spouse, raising their children to love God and His kingdom, and honoring their parents, all with a view to being a blessing to the wider world.

D. Benediction: Psalm 115:14-15

IX. Called To Citizenship

A. Theme: Christians are called to serve God in their nation and culture, submitting to their leaders, and serving in the government and wider culture with unbelievers to promote the common good, always remembering that their true home is the new heavens and the new earth.

B. Text: Romans 13:1-7; Jeremiah 29:4-7; Philippians 3:20-21

C. Response: Prayer
