 - 1. Theme: As he arrived at Philippi Paul had survived conflict, been strengthened by new partners, and was guided and empowered by the Holy Spirit.
 - 2. Text: Acts 15:36-16:15
 - 3. Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:2-10
- B. The Founding of the Church at Philippi (Part 2)
 - 1. Theme: God sovereignly works by His Spirit to draw people from all backgrounds to Himself, and to sustain our joy even in times of suffering.
 - 2. Text: Acts 16:11-40
 - 3. Reading: Philippians 2:1-4

II. The Letter to the Philippians

- A. Greetings, Thanksgiving and Prayer
 - 1. The Apostolic Greeting
 - a. Theme: The apostles, slaves of Christ, wrote to God's holy people to bless them with grace and peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - b. Text: Philippians 1:1-2
 - c. Reading: Psalm 98
 - 2. Partners in Gospel Ministry
 - a. Theme: As Paul remembers the Philippians, he is filled with thanksgiving and joy because of their close partnership with him in the Gospel, and confidence because of God's sustaining grace.
 - b. Text: Philippians 1:3-8
 - c. Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24
 - 3. Paul's Prayer for the Philippians
 - Theme: Paul prays that we would grow in love and discernment so that our lives will bring glory and praise to God.
 - b. Text: Philippians 1:9-11
 - c. Reading: Psalm 9:7-11

B. Paul's Situation

- 1. Joy in the Journey (Part 1): Proclaiming Christ
 - a. Theme: Despite very difficult personal circumstances, Paul is filled with joy because Christ is being proclaimed.
 - b. Text: Philippians 1:12-18a
 - c. Reading: 2 Timothy 2:1-10
- 2. Joy in the Journey (Part 2): Our Future With Christ
 - a. Theme: We can have joy because life is an opportunity to know and serve Christ, and death brings us into His Presence, which is the deepest desire of our hearts.
 - b. Text: Philippians 1:18b-26
 - c. Reading: 2 Corinthians 4:13-18
- C. A Life Worthy of the Gospel: Exhortations to the Community
 - 1. Unity and Courage in the Face of Opposition
 - a. Theme: As citizens of the heavenly Kingdom believers must live worthy of the Gospel, walking in unity with each other and standing with courage when faced with opposition.
 - b. Text: Philippians 1:27-30
 - c. Reading: 2 Thessalonians 1:1-12

2. Unity Through Humility

- a. Theme: As citizens of heaven who have been blessed by God, we are to walk in humility before God and each other, which leads to unity in the church.
- b. Text: Philippians 2:1-4
- c. Reading: Isaiah 66:1-2
- 3. Jesus Christ the Supreme Example of Humility
 - a. Theme: As citizens of heaven, we look to Jesus, Who is the Supreme example of humility and the Lord of all.
 - b. Text: Philippians 2:5-11
 - c. Reading: Isaiah 45:18-25
- 4. A Fruitful Life of Joyful Obedience
 - Theme: Paul calls believers to draw upon God's strength to live fruitful lives of joyful obedience.
 - b. Text: Philippians 2:12-18
 - c. Reading: Romans 15:1-6

D. Looking to the Future

- Timothy and Epaphroditus Christ-like Examples for Us
 - a. Theme: Timothy and Epaphroditus were Christ-like examples, serving others even at great personal sacrifice and risk.

b. Text: Philippians 2:19-30

c. Reading: 2 Corinthians 1:3-7

- 2. Our Confidence in Christ: Holding on to the Gospel
 - a. Theme: The continental divide of life is where we place our confidence – ourselves and our own righteousness, or Christ and His righteousness.

b. Text: Philippians 3:1-11

c. Reading: Galatians 3:6-14

- 3. Our Present Struggle and Our Future Glory
 - a. Theme: The Christian life is characterized by the pursuit of Christ, the struggle against sin, and the hope of our glorious future in heaven with Christ.

b. Text: Philippians 3:12-21

c. Reading: Colossians 3:1-11

E. Final Exhortations and Thanksgiving

- 1. The Call to Live in Community
 - a. Theme: Paul urges believers to walk in community so that they can stand for the Gospel in the face of opposition.

b. Text: Philippians 4:1-3

c. Reading: Psalm 133

2. A Godward Life

a. Theme: Rather than facing our circumstances with anxiety, we should draw near to God and live for Him, knowing the God of peace is with us.

b. Text: Philippians 4:1-9

c. Reading: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24

3. A Life of Joyful Contentment

a. Theme: Christ enables us to live a life of joyful thanksgiving, regardless of the circumstances of our present existence.

b. Text: Philippians 4:10-23

c. Reading: Ephesians 3:14-21

III. Epilogue: The Heart of Philippians

- A. The Centrality of Christ and His Gospel
 - 1. Theme: The central issue of true life is Christ and His Gospel, which give us life and should be central in our thought and existence.
 - 2. Text: Philippians 1:21; 27a
 - 3. Reading: Galatians 6:12-18
- B. Living As A Community of Joy
 - Theme: As we walk in community with a focus on our eternal inheritance, we can experience joy, no matter what our circumstances are at present.
 - 2. Text: Philippians 1:4-6
 - 3. Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:4-9
