- A. Theme: Ever since the Fall, sin and culture have disintegrated community and encouraged isolation from God and one another.
- B. Text: Genesis 3:1-24
- C. Response: Communion
- D. Benediction: Hebrews 13:20-21

IV. The Restoration of Community

- A. Theme: The possibility of true community with God and one another is restored in Christ and may be experienced in His people, the Church.
- B. Text: Ephesians 2:11-22
- C. Response: Prayer
- D. Benediction: Romans 15:5-6
